Collins Bay Yacht Club Amendments to the Sailing Instructions Long Point Challenge June 24-25, 2017

Amendment 1

Sailing Instruction 10 is changed to the following:

10 The Start

- 10.2 If less than 4 boats are included in any class the start will be as follows:
 - 10.2.1 At the skippers' meeting (0900 24/06/2017) one boat will be designated as the "start" boat
 - 10.2.2 The start area will be near the mouth of Collins Bay near the cardinal mark at approximately 44°13.453N 76°37.637W
 - 10.2.3 At 1030 the start boat will begin sailing back and forth across the start area keeping the wind on the beam. All other boats will sail to the leeward side of the start boat's course
 - 10.2.4 At 1034 the start boat will sound a signal and begin a port tack with wind on the beam. All other boats will fall in behind the start boat on port tack.
 - 10.2.5 At 1035 the start will be signalled by the start boat tacking onto a starboard course. All other boats will tack onto starboard sailing below the start boat.

Amendment 2

Sailing Instruction 11 is changed to the following:

11 The Finish

- 11.1 If a shortened course (instruction 8.2) has not been declared the finish line will be between the green and red southernmost private channel navigation buoys in Collins Bay, at approximately 44°14.247N 76°36.871W.
- 11.2 Racing boats shall record their finish time (GPS). If a Committee Boat is not on station at the finish, the skipper shall report the finish time to the Race Officer (geoff.roulet@queensu.ca) within 24 hours of finishing; otherwise the boat will be scored DNF.
