## COME ENJOY A SUMMER ON THE WATER 2018 YOUTH & ADULT SAILING PROGRAMS

### Youth Programs

#### **Monday to Friday 9:00am - 4:00pm**

For students ages 8 to 17 – beginner to advanced – **No Experience Required.** Supervision ashore and afloat by our certified CANSail (CYA) Instructors. Using our Topper-Topaz 14' Dinghies, we take each student through the basics of sailing including rigging a boat, points of sail, rules on the water and general sailing safety. We ensure that our instructors-student ratio exceeds national and provincial guidelines.

**CANSail 3 & 4** covers more advanced sailing skills in our Club 420s: stronger winds, tuning a boat, sailing theory, boat maintenance, use of spinnakers.

**CANSail 5** is a Learn-to-Race program which fully integrates boat handling with tactics and strategy. Classes are taught on the student's Laser Radial (single-handed) or our Club 420s (double-handed).

### Youth Programs (Continued)

**CANSail 1 & 2** (beginner): \$600 per 2-week session.\*

**CANSail 3 & 4** (intermediate): \$650 per 2-week session.\*

**CANSail 5** (advanced): \$1250 (double-handed) or \$1150 (single-handed) per 4-week session.\*†

### Adult Learn-to Sail (LTS) Programs

#### **Monday & Wednesday 6:00pm - 9:00pm**

Our adult programs are designed for adults (18+) with no prior experience, and offer an opportunity to learn basic sailing skills, and experience the pleasure of sailing.

We offer two adult courses:

**Adult LTS Dinghy** follows the Sail Canada CANSAIL 1&2 program. Using our 14' Topper-Topaz dinghies, you will learn about wind direction, points of sail, how to control the sails, tack and gybe the boat, and how to right a capsized boat.

Cost: \$300 per 3-week (6 class) session.\*  
Sessions start Monday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018.

**Adult LTS Keelboat** follows the Sail Canada Start-Keelboat-Sailing program. Using our club's 22' Tanzer sailboat, you will learn the skills and knowledge to safely handle a similar boat under power and sail in moderate conditions.

Cost: \$375 per 3-week (6 class) session.  
Sessions start Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup> 2018.

Adult LTS Keelboat is also offered as a one-weekend condensed session on Friday evening and all-day Saturday and Sunday.
