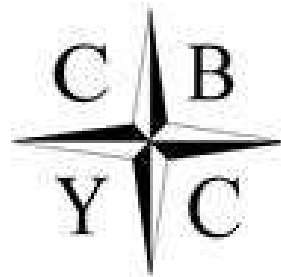

Adult Sailing

(For ages 18 and older)

Adult keelboat instruction is designed for sailors with no prior experience. It follows the Sail Canada start-keelboat-sailing program. Aboard a Tanzer 22' sailboat, you will learn skills and knowledge to safely handle a similar boat under power and sail in light to moderate conditions.

Weekend sessions: Friday 6 to 9 p.m., plus all-day Saturday and Sunday. Starting Friday, May 22, 2020. – Weekday sessions: Monday and Wednesday 6 to 9 p.m. for three weeks (6 classes). Starting the last week of May.

Adult dinghy programming follows the CANSail 1+2 program. If interested, contact us for more information.

Youth Dinghy Sailing

(For ages 8 to 17)

CANSail 1 (no experience required) teaches sailors fundamental skills including rigging, basic sheeting, boat handling and general sailing safety. **CANSail 2** basic sailing teaches sailors to adjust their bodies and boats for changes in direction and wind speed, placing more emphasis on skippering.

CANSail 3 intermediate sailing integrates fundamental boat handling manoeuvres and balance with basic tactics and strategy as well as applied sail trim. **CANSail 4** intermediate sailing covers advanced boat handling manoeuvres in a variety of conditions including competitive settings. Introduction to spinnaker use.

CANSail 5 advanced sailing fully integrates boat handling with tactics and strategy. Sailors are also introduced to the concept of rig tuning. **CANSail 6** advanced sailing trains sailors to perform all skills in all conditions in order to achieve accurate sailing.

Double-handed sailing is taught using CBYC C-420 dinghies and single-handed sailing using Laser Radials (bring-your-own).
