Notice of Race (NoR)

Collins Bay Yacht Club (CBYC) Sailing School (SS) invites you to participate in the inaugural 2 Generation Regatta where SS students and their parents/legal guardians have the opportunity to showcase the skills and knowledge acquired over the sail training season in a series of fun dinghy races.

Collins Bay Yacht Club (CBYC) Sailing School (SS) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the 2 Generation Regatta.

The notation [DP] indicates that the penalty may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification. The World Sailing Guidelines for Discretionary Penalties will be used.

The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 60.1(a).

1 RULES

1.1 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 hrs. 16 Aug. 2024 at https://collinsbaymarina.com/cbyc/sailing-school/sailing-school-downloads/.
- 2.2 The sailing instructions (SIs) will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard SIs and supplementary SIs that will be on the official notice board located at the CBYC Clubhouse (S.S. Maria) and https://collinsbaymarina.com/cbyc/sailing-school/sailing-school-downloads/.

3 COMMUNICATION

- **3.1** The online official notice board is located at https://collinsbaymarina.com/cbyc/sailing-school-downloads/.
- 3.2 On the water, the Race Committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on the VHF radio or via loud hailer. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The event is open to all students of the 2024 CBYC Sailing School program and their parents/legal guardians.
- **4.2** SS students are required to helm their boat with parents/legal guardians participating as crew.
- 4.3 Owing to the format of this regatta and the time available to complete it, only the first 24 Sailing School Students and their crews will be able to participate.
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the 2024 2 Generation Regatta, a boat shall complete and submit the 2 Generation Regatta Registration Form available in hard copy from Jayna Mandin, Head Coach/Instructor or on-line at:

5 FEES

The entry fee for this regatta is \$30/crew (i.e., SS student & parent/legal guardian). Payment can be made in cash to Jayna Mandin or by e-transfer at school@collinsbayyachtclub.ca.

6 SCHEDULE

7 VENUE

7.1 The course racing will be held in the protected waters of Collins Bay as outlined in Addendum 1.

8 COURSES

8.1 The windward – leeward courses will utilize inflatable drop marks of variable leg length to achieve individual races of approx. 15 minutes duration.

9 SCORING

- **9.1** RRS A4, the "Low Point Scoring System" will be used to score all races.
- **9.2** The top three boats from each 'flight' will move on to the semi-final round of races.
- **9.3** The top 3 boats from the semi-final 'flights' will move on to the championship race.
- **9.4** RRS A5.3 applies.

10 RISK STATEMENT

10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

11 INSURANCE

11.1 Boats and crews participating in this regatta are covered by CBYC's insurance should an incident be determined to be the result of SS error.

12 PRIZES

- **12.1** Prizes will be awarded as follows:
- **12.2** 1st, 2nd & 3rd place 'Championship' round.
