ALL THINGS ELECTRICAL

You might wonder why we don't allow swimming at the Marina. The simple answer is there may be stray current from the boats or Marina that could cause drowning.

Electric shock drowning is when electric currents leak into surrounding bodies of water, causing the water to become energized. Electric-shock drowning happens when an electric current, typically low-level AC current from boats, docks, or lights, "escapes" and shocks nearby swimmers. The shock paralyzes them, so they can't swim or help themselves.

- Please do not use a household extension cord to plug in your boat and do not let the cord hang loosely in the water. Live power cords must not be left on the dock where they may fall into the water. Disconnect cords from the power outlet before disconnecting them from the boat.
- Unattended use of power in the winter is prohibited. It is a serious fire hazard and will void your boat insurance policy.

While we are sourcing and planning for a dedicated Electric Vehicle charging station in the future, this year we will be offering all those with electric vehicles an opportunity to purchase a power pass for access to plug in your electric vehicle while at the marina. If EV charging is not on your invoice, contact the office!
